

Shevat 5785 Prayer Declarations: Dispossessing & Possessing the Land



Prayer Declarations for Shevat 5785

1. Declaration of Righteousness as Our Foundation

"Father, I declare that my righteousness is rooted in You, Jehovah Tzidkenu, the Lord my Righteousness. I align myself with Your truth and walk in holiness, knowing that my foundation is secure in Christ!" (*Jeremiah* 23:6)

4. Declaration of Awakening & Refreshing

"I decree that my roots are awakening to the water of life! As the river of God flows, I am being refreshed, renewed, and strengthened in my spirit." (Jeremiah 17:7-8)

5. Declaration of Bold Possession of Promised Territory

"This year, I am battling for my high places! I will not be intimidated by giants, delays, or distractions. I move forward in power, taking hold of every promise You have given me!" (Deuteronomy 11:24)

6. Declaration of Dispossession & Replacement of Wicked Rule

"As the Israelites had to dispossess the land before they could possess it, I declare that every enemy occupying my promise must be removed! I replace every ungodly structure with Kingdom rule and dominion!" (*Numbers 33:53-54*)

7. Declaration of Divine Instruction & Alignment

"Lord, I commit to listening for divine instruction this month. Just as Moses gave wisdom before the Israelites entered the land, I will align with Your word and receive Your strategies!" (Deuteronomy 6:4-5)

8. Declaration of Strength in Transition

"I will not grow weary in the process! Even if I feel like I am 'in the middle,' I trust that You are preparing me for the promise. My wilderness season has a purpose, and I will step into the fullness of what You have for me!" (Isaiah 40:31)

9. Declaration of Identity & Stability in Christ

"I declare that my identity is rooted in Christ, not in my circumstances! As I move into new places, I will not be shaken by temporary challenges. I remain steadfast in God's truth!" (Psalm 16:8)

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10. SHOUT: "MY BLESSINGS ARE ON THE WAY!"

"In this Shevat 5785, I lift my voice and declare: My blessings are on the way! The breath of God is moving, my high places are secure, and the supernatural supply of the Lord is flowing into my life!" (Genesis 45:27)

Understanding Shevat 5785: A Time of Transition, Battle & Blessing

Shevat is the 11th month of the Hebrew calendar, linked to the tribe of Asher, which represents abundance, joy, and divine provision. However, this month is not just about receiving blessings—it is about warring for possession and standing in righteousness.

Key Themes of Shevat

- Righteousness as the Foundation (Tzadik 2) The Hebrew letter Tzadik symbolizes "the righteous one." Shevat is a month to root ourselves in righteousness so we can stand firm and bear fruit. (Psalm 1:3)
- Dispossessing & Possessing the Land After Moses died in Shevat, the Israelites had to dispossess the land before they could possess it. This means we must tear down demonic strongholds and establish God's Kingdom wherever we go. (Numbers 33:53)
- Awakening to the Water of Life (Aquarius The Water Bearer) Shevat is a time of spiritual refreshing. As the river of God touches our roots, we awaken to new life and strength. (Jeremiah 17:7-8)
- **Hearing & Aligning with Divine Instruction** Before Israel could enter the land, Moses gave them wisdom for how to live as a **set-apart people**. Shevat is a month to **listen carefully and align with God's strategies**. (*Deuteronomy 6:4-5*)
- From Wilderness to Promise Many feel like they are "in the middle," but Shevat is a turning point. Just as Israel prepared to cross the Jordan, we must be ready for transition and breakthrough. (Isaiah 40:31)
- 5785: Battling for the High Places We are in the year 5785, a Hei Pey year, which means God's breath is propelling us forward, and we must declare with authority. The enemy will not give up territory easily, but we are anointed to battle and reclaim dominion! (Deuteronomy 11:24)

Final Charge: Step into the Promise!

Shevat 5785 is a month of **bold action**. It's time to:

• Recognize that transition requires battle

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- Dispossess before possessing
- Stand firm in righteousness
- Listen carefully to God's strategies
