

Celebrating the Hebrew Month of Av & Prayers and Decrees

Today marks the beginning of the Hebrew month of Av, a significant time in the Jewish calendar. As an apostolic equipping center, Kingdom Center Rockford invites you to understand its profound meaning and align with God's divine blueprint for the months.

Drawing inspiration from Chuck D. Pierce's book "A Time to Advance," we explore the depth of this month:

Av at a Glance:

- **Month:** Av (30 days July/August)
- **Alphabet:** TET resembles a womb; a month when the earth contracts, moving the secret of pregnancy into the earthly realm.
- **Tribe:** Simeon to hear; be concerned.
- Characteristics:
 - Metamorphosis or disintegration.
 - o The month the Lion roars. (Amos 3:8)
 - o A time of destruction and reconstruction by God.
 - o Develop a new level of discernment based on what you hear.
 - Listen carefully for key impressions.
- **Constellation:** Leo (the lion) representing the divine will of the Father being executed.
- Color/Stone: Green/Emerald.

Av, the fifth month of the Jewish calendar, holds both a history of sorrow and a promise of redemption. It is a month where key events have shaped the destiny of Israel, often marked by destruction due to unbelief. The 9th of Av, in particular, is significant in Israel's history, being a day associated with tragic events.

A Choice to Break the Cycle: Av presents us with a crucial choice:

- Receive a Curse or Break a Curse.
- Believe God's Promise or Enter God's Blessing.

Let's choose to mix His promise with faith, transforming this month into a time of blessing. Av is also the month of Simeon, and through the redemptive power of Jesus, we can overcome iniquitous patterns in our lives.



Spiritual Significance:

- **Hearing and Understanding:** Av is a month to hear and understand. Decisions made now will have lasting impacts.
- **The Lion Roars:** This month is about the divine will being executed and creating a prophetic covering (Amos 3:8).
- **Partnership and Discernment:** Be mindful of your partnerships and seek new levels of discernment.

Embrace the Promise: The letter TET, associated with Av, symbolizes a womb, indicating that new things are being conceived and will manifest. As we align with God's purposes, let's walk in freedom, break past curses, and enter into the blessings He has prepared for us.

Encouragement: As we journey through Av, let's embrace its potential for transformation. Seek His guidance, develop discernment, and allow God to reconstruct areas of our lives that need change. May we roar with the Lion of Judah, proclaiming His will on earth as it is in heaven.

Declarations and Prayers for Av

- **1. Declaration of Divine Reconstruction** "I declare that God is at work reconstructing and restoring every area of my life. Just as He allows destruction to rebuild anew, I trust Him to bring forth beauty from ashes in my life. (Isaiah 61:3)"
 - **Prayer for Renewal** "Father, thank You for Your promise of renewal. As we reflect on the past, we look forward with hope. Restore the broken areas of our lives and bring new growth and opportunities this season. In Jesus' name, Amen."
- **2. Declaration of Faith and Promise** "I declare that I choose to believe in God's promises and enter into His blessings. I reject the spirit of unbelief and embrace the faith that overcomes all obstacles. (Hebrews 4:1-2)"
 - **Prayer for Faith** "Lord, we reject unbelief and choose to trust in Your promises. Strengthen our faith to enter the blessings You have prepared for us. May we always mix Your promises with faith and see Your goodness in our lives. In Jesus' name, Amen."
- **3. Declaration of Hearing and Discernment** "I declare that I will listen carefully to God's voice and develop a new level of discernment. I will not oppose wise counsel but will heed it to grow in wisdom and understanding. (Psalm 32:8)"
 - **Prayer for Discernment** "God, grant us ears to hear Your voice and hearts to discern Your will. Help us to be receptive to wise counsel and to grow in understanding and wisdom during this month. In Jesus' name, Amen."
- **4. Declaration of Divine Will and Purpose** "I declare that the divine will of the Father is being executed in my life. I align myself with God's purposes and embrace His plans, knowing they are for my good. (Jeremiah 29:11)"
 - **Prayer for Alignment** "Father, we align ourselves with Your divine will and purposes. Guide our steps and help us to walk in Your plans, trusting that they are for our good and Your glory. In Jesus' name, Amen."



- **5. Declaration of Strength and Courage** "I declare that I am strong and courageous in the Lord. Even in the face of adversity, I will stand firm, knowing that the Lion of Judah roars on my behalf. (Amos 3:8)"
 - **Prayer for Strength** "Lord, we ask for Your strength and courage as we face the challenges ahead. Empower us to stand firm in faith, knowing that You are with us and that Your roar brings protection and victory. In Jesus' name, Amen."
- **6. Declaration of New Beginnings** "I declare that this month marks the beginning of new things in my life. Just as a womb carries new life, I will see the birth of new dreams, visions, and opportunities. (Isaiah 43:19)"
 - **Prayer for New Beginnings** "God, we thank You for the new beginnings that You bring. As the secret of new life moves into the earth realm, let it manifest in our lives. Birth new dreams, visions, and opportunities within us. In Jesus' name, Amen."

As we journey through the month of Av, let us remember that our God is a God of restoration, faith, and new beginnings. May these declarations and prayers fortify our faith and draw us closer to Him. Let us embrace this season with hearts full of expectancy, knowing that God is doing a new thing in our lives and our community.
